<p>When trying to save a style, nothing happens. No crash, but also nothing saved.</p> <p>When trying to save as 'sld' format, gives error:</p> <p>"ERROR: failed to create sld file as . Check file permissions and retry."</p> <p>Works fine under Linux.</p>
