<b>Description</b>	
<p>The <i>Print Composer</i> window needs a minimum size restriction, so that it always shows all the data entry fields full size. A user is able to make the window too small to show everything. Similarly, the first time you open <i>Print Composer</i> after loading QGIS, the window is too small.</p> <p>This flaw – data entry boxes all scrunched up – gives QGIS a faulty look.</p>
