<p>When placing text, the vertical aligning has an unsupported value: It seems that both "top" and "cap" are currently interpreted the same. The "Cap" value seems to work ok, whereas the "top" value is wrong.</p> <p>This issue leads to inconsistent rendering if you exchange data with other GIS systems that also support these 5 vertical align values.</p> <p>See attached picture with an explanation of the values.</p>
