If you set up a Custom size sheet of paper in Print Composer, the *Height* and *Width* are overridden by the Orientation setting.

eg if you want a 200mm width and 100mm height, but the Orientation is set to Portrait, you get 100mm width and 200 height.

I don't think Orientation should override a Custom paper size. When Custom is chosen, Orientation should be grayed.
