<p>If you set up a Custom size sheet of paper in Print Composer, the <i>Height</i> and <i>Width</i> are overridden by the Orientation setting.</p> <p>eg if you want a 200mm width and 100mm height, but the Orientation is set to <i>Portrait</i>, you get 100mm width and 200 height.</p> <p>I don't think Orientation should override a Custom paper size. When Custom is chosen, Orientation should be grayed.</p>
