<p>While testing the transparency/WMS bug, I looked in the logs for the WMS.</p> <p>For some reason during this period of changing transparency, QGIS had requested a couple of small, 120*120 maps that are very zoomed out - so kind of like overview maps. I don't have an overview map in QGIS; I didn't even know that was possible.</p> <p>I've attached the section of log files. The two anomalous requests are for height=120.</p>
