| <p>I open a project that has a WMS layer defined, but I am offline. The project loads till it gets to the WMS layer then hangs indefinitely waiting for a response. The only option is to kill QGIS.</p> <p>Manually edit the WMS layer out, or remove it when online and the problem disappears.</p> <p>So QGIS needs to timeout very quickly if it receives no response and just switch the layer off, or some other smooth way of handling the error.</p> <p>This is an issue on 1.8 but worth testing in 2.0</p> |                        |                                     |
