<p>Please see the screencast:</p> <p>https://www.dropbox.com/s/ubn20f6fywrrtod/node_tool.avi</p> <p>It happens in Windows and Linux, both with points, lines and polygons, with shapefiles and postgis layers.</p> <p>In Linux, despite select another layer in the TOC, node tool continues to edit the vertices of the previous selected layer. To overcome, you need to select another tool (Add feature, Move Feature, Pan, Zoom in/out, etc..) and back again to the node tool.</p> <p>This does not happen in 1.8.</p>
