<p>Hi</p> <p>The standalone windows installer for QGIS includes the python matplotlib module required for (among other things?) the contour plugin, but is missing the dateutil module on which it depends. So currently anything trying to use matplotlib will fail :-)</p> <p>Could the dateutil module be added to the installer please?</p>
