<p>When you make <i>Zoom to layer extent</i> on point layers, some of the points are partially or even completely out of the Map View and its necessary to zoom out a little bit to be able to see them.</p> <p>IMHO also with other feature types <i>Zoom to layer</i> is excessive and it would be better to have some space around the zoomed layer.</p>
