Steps to reproduce:

- 1. Create a new project
- 2. Create a new composer sheet
- 3. Add a legend item
- 4. Activate the [x] Frame and set the thickness value to 3.00
- 5. Close the composer sheet window
- 6. Save the new project (any name, anywhere)
- 7. Load the project you just saved (quickly accessed via open recent > sub menu)
- 8. Re-open the composer sheet, and notice how the legend item frame revert/reset to 0.00

That's a regression affecting QGIS master (2.1).
