<p>When a symbol is defined with map units, it is sometimes shown in the legend at a very small scale, preventing to see the details.</p> <p>If millimeters are used for symbol size, it is displayed in the legend at the right size.</p> <p>A solution could be to used map units for the symbol display on the map, but fixed size for the symbol in the legend.</p>
