Steps to reproduce: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Open the attached project</li><li>2. Open the label property of the vector layer, go in the background section, and notice the offset Y value is set to 1</li><li>3. Close the label property, and open 'Composer 1'</li><li>4. Export the composer to an image</li><li>5. Open the image to witness the label background wrongly placed way below the label</li></ol>
