<b>Description</b>	
Currently tools that are related to the layer widget are only within the context menu of layers. This is bad, as <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- they are 'hidden' by default</li><li>- they don't refer to the current clicked layer, but to all layers (more specific: the layer list itself)</li></ul> So I suggest to move the expand/collapse/add group feature to a small toolbar at the top of the layer window. You might have a look how the Eclipse team designed it: !eclipse_outline_window.png!
