The WMS at this URL doesn't work, apparently because a couple of the URL's in the resultant GetCapabilities (the xsd files) are invalid (return 404s): <a href="http://inspire.landregistry.gov.uk/inspire/ows">http://inspire.landregistry.gov.uk/inspire/ows</a>		
The feature request is that QGIS ignore these URL's and serve the layer normally if possible.		
May also be applicable for other OGC services.
