The error occurs for dbf and sqlite.</p> <p>It happens using the GRASS Toolbox and the MINGW shell and there is no error message during import but when I try to load the file in QGIS the message ("Cannot select attributes from table...") occurs.</p> <p>Looking in the current GRASS location/Mapset the dbf folder is empty.</p> <p>This error was also confirmed by Matthew Perry</p> <p>Regards, Otto</p>
