This would be a great feature!

I would add a possibility to link feature styles to styles in style manager.

Styles could be stored in a global style library or to a project file. This would work mostly in the same way than styles in many word processing software.

Also same kind of principle for just colors would be great. Imagine situation where you have multiple styles for roads with different widths but with the same fill and casing colors. If you just want to change the color of casing or fill for all road styles you could do that just once.
