Hi !	
I frequently encounter the following bug : depending on other layer's visibility, some labels (of polyline layers) are moved to an endpoint of the line rather than being display in the middle.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- This does not happen at all scales and I couldn't manage to find out when it's happening and when not.</li><li>- I tried to play around with some render settings, but it seems there's no relevant option to avoid this.</li><li>- The bug is already present in 2.0.1.</li></ul>	
See the screenshots :	
A - display is as expected	
B - when activating another layer, one of the label moved it's position	
I can provide a test file upon request (I'd rather not post it here, but can send it privately without problem)
