<p>Hi,</p> <p>Sometimes, it is nice to give labels the same color as the objets they refer to.</p> <p>When there are too many classes, this can be a bit tedious.</p> <p>The "expression plus" plugin comes with the ability to get the color from a given (continuous) ramp.</p> <p>It would be nice to have the same system with discrete qualitative ramps. If the ramp has 5 classes, then we could use <code>ramp_color_rgb('[qual. ramp],[1 to 5]</code></p> <p>Also, why not directly setting a column with the color set in the symbology ?</p>
