<p>Currently when adding an Oracle layer QGIS performs a MBR check against the layer (SDO_TUNE.EXTENTS_OF). This hangs QGIS for several minutes if the table is a large one (millions of rows) and/or/especially if there are multiple tables.</p> <p>An approximate MBR is already held in the MDSYS.USER_SDO_GEOM_METADATA - this should be used instead.</p> <p>I'd suggest assigning it to "use estimated table metadata" checkboxes so people who want the exact boundaries (i.e. those who don't keep their GEOM up to date) can use those instead.</p>
