Choose remove point button (also created by QGIS and definitely not right, will send as another bug later).</p> <p>First bug: Right-click on 0,0 point - for some reason point 104,52 removed (I know right click is not supposed to remove points, but this is still incorrect behavior).</p> <p>Second bug: Keep right-clicking anywhere on the map - QGIS crashes.</p> <p>See attachments.</p>
