For some reason installing 2.3 (from the weeklies) has made 2.2 unable to find the Oracle Provider.

That's why QGIS isn't able to open those files - because there is no Oracle provider available.

So assuming that's the cause, the bug is that the handler is appearing when really there should be an error telling the user that the Oracle provider needs

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installing (on that front, probably relate it to #9636).
