QGIS crashes when attempting to 'save as...' of a vector layer in different projection

Description		
<p>Hi,</p> <p>QGIS crashes as soon as I try and save an existing vector layer as a shapefile in projection that differs from the original.</p> <p>A bit of background, I recently recompiled GDAL with MrSID support (using a third party SDK), though this caused problems as it introduced an older version of the Geos library than QGIS was compiled against. I recompiled GDAL again without MrSID support (i.e. reverting back to the way I had it before) though now I am experiencing the problem above.</p> <p>That said, this is the first time I've attempted to 'save as...' since the upgrade to QGIS 2.2. so am unsure if its a QGIS issue or if I've broken GDAL.</p> <p>I can replicate the problem when trying to save in a number of different projections. If I 'save as...' using the same project as the original the export works fine and QGIS doesn't crash. One last thing is that the first time it happened a pop-up appeared with a list of libraries that are being used (see attached screenshot).</p> <p>Any help greatly appreciated.</p> <p>Marty</p>
