<p>1. Add a [[PostGIS]] layer.</p> <p>2. Add 3 new columns to it, in QGIS table editor: col1, col2, col3.</p> <p>3. Drop "col2".</p> <p>4. All QGIS tools start claiming that you have 2 "col3" columns. Of course that's not true. Re-add the layer or start digitizing it and all is fine again.</p>
