Creating a SL DB from New layer works well. When doing the same from the Browser, there are two issues:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- the file created does not have a .sqlite (or similar) extension, so it is difficult to find</li><li>- the newly created DB is not registered among the available DBs.</li></ul>
